PINE-PINUS	Mugo Pine <i>7ft x 7ft / 2m x 2m</i>	Mushroom shaped growth pattern with bright green needles.
	Dwarf Mugo Pine <i>4ft x 7ft / 1.25m x 2m</i>	Dense, low-growing form of mugo pine. Good in rock gardens.
	Mountain Pine <i>33ft x 16ft / 10m x 5m</i>	Broad pyramid form evergreen.
	Ponderosa Pine <i>50ft x 20ft / 15m x 6m</i>	This pine has beautiful cinnamon brown bark that shows better as it matures.
	Scotch Pine <i>50ft x 20ft / 15m x 6m</i>	Very hardy fast growing pine. Blue-green needles.
	Bristlecone Pine	
	Swiss Stone Pine <i>40ft x 20ft / 13m x 6m</i>	Interesting growth pattern. Soft blue-green needles.
	Lodgepole Pine <i>60ft x 20ft / 16m x 6m</i>	Alberta's provincial tree, open airy growth habit. Tall and slender.

SPRUCE-PICEA	Bakeri Spruce <i>12ft x 6ft / 3.5m x 1.5m</i>	Loose columnar growth habit. Vibrant blue needles on strong stems.
	Colorado Blue <i>65ft x 26ft / 20m x 8m</i>	Very popular specimen evergreen that is drought tolerant. Useful shelterbelt tree.
	Fastigiata Blue <i>20ft x 7ft / 6m x 2m</i>	Good evergreen for narrow spaces. Good blue colour.
	Fat Albert Spruce <i>33ft x 16ft / 10m x 5m</i>	Dense pyramidal growth habit. Steely blue colour.
	Hoopsi Blue Spruce <i>30ft x 10ft / 9m x 3m</i>	Pointy - Narrow growing evergreen with silver blue needles.
	Serbian Spruce <i>40ft x 25ft / 13m x 8m</i>	Thin arching branches on slender straight trunk. Green-blue needles.
	White Spruce <i>45ft x 20ft / 14m x 6m</i>	An excellent specimen evergreen with dark green needles.
